












WHAT WE DO: THE ACTIVITIES

Situation analysis of delegating parties by participants, according to given criteria, first submitted as a paper and later presented in seminar



SUCCESS STORIES

Nino Jintcharadzé (Georgia) from UNM started the "Youth for Development" project. The goal is to promote youth's democratic engagement in a political party, as well as raising awareness towards fair elections as the basis of democratic processes. She trained 50 volunteers for municipal election observation in Ajara region, who were controlling 300 polling



stations during the last local elections. For the next elections they plan to cover all Georgian regions.



Doina Gherman (Moldova), participant of PAS arrived to our seminar by bus and was appalled by conditions. She conducted opinion research on travel safety and started an advocacy campaign, submitted a petition to the National Auto Transport Agency, formulated recommendations for improving the legal framework and contacted the Consumer Protection Agency.

Additionally, she's recently become President of the PAS Women organisation which she helped found. From now on she can actively participate in political decision making.

Oksana Straz (Ukraine), participant from the Samopomich party conducted opinion research on internet security for children in cooperation with the police. After having the topic on agenda of the local party organization and city council meetings, they visited every school with a training lesson for kids, had 10 open meetings on that topic, created an expert group - an official working group with a citywide



program on cyber security which also advised on how to change state policy in this field.
